*Parents: Please be aware of a change in the process for handling tardies for the 2017-18 school year. We believe that students being in class on time has a direct impact on their learning and success in the classroom. With that in mind, after the 7th tardy for the semester, students will receive a written warning from their Assistant Principal. After the 10th tardy, the student will be placed in a 30 minute detention, and parents will be notified. Every 2 additional tardies will result in doubling the length of detention time assigned.
