



Attendance

Parents:

Regular school attendance is essential for a student to make the most of his or her education. Absences from class may result in serious disruption of a student's mastery of instructional materials. In addition to the loss of instruction, state law makes school attendance mandatory.

Students with excessive absences may be subject to referral to truancy court and/or loss of course credit. It is imperative that

documentation be provided for any and all absences that occur throughout the year. Documentation from a parent or doctor needs to be submitted within 2 days of a student's return to school. Notes can be submitted in person, or electronically to our attendance clerk, Ms. Walker.

Even if the student does not see a doctor, a parent note is important so that we have documentation of the reason for the absence.
