I can't believe another year is ending. Thank you for sharing your student with us! Our summer hours are as follows in case you need anything before the start of next school year.

mLISD News

Leander Mobile Learning Initiative (mLISD) supports the vision outlined in our Graduate Profile that "Leander ISD students are well prepared to enrich our world and excel in a global society" and that "each student is challenged, encouraged, and supported to achieve the highest level of knowledge, skills, and character" in a digital world.

Once again this year, students who are currently participating in the mLISD program have the option to keep their district devices over the summer. Students can begin to pay the support fee of \$70 (\$35 for students on free/reduced lunch) from April 1st through May 19th. Scholarship opportunities are available and the application can be picked up in the counseling office.

Payment will be accepted for the 2019-2020 school year starting April 1st. For credit card payments, click [HERE](#) to sign-up and pay. For cash or money order, bring the payment and the completed [Student and Parent Acceptance Form](#) to the front office.

Personal and cashier's checks are not accepted.

Assistant Principal's Message:

GRADUATION DAY INFORMATION

Our goal is to always have a well organized and dignified ceremony to honor your student(s), our seniors. In an effort to give you and your families advance information, listed below are some important details regarding our senior class activities. We hope you will find this information helpful and will refer back to it as we get closer to the end of your senior year.

Student Transportation:

All students must ride on buses to the HEB Center. Buses will depart from the Rouse High School student parking area. This will ensure maximum organization and minimal confusion. LISD Buses will be used to transport students.

After graduation, students may ride home with family and/or friends.

Students should arrive at RHS:

No later than **1:45pm** and report to their assigned rooms in the science building.

Student Dress:

Our students should be in their best possible appearance at this very important event.

- **Girls:** are expected to wear a dress or long pants and blouse under their graduation gown (no jeans).
- **Boys:** are expected to wear socks, long pants, collared shirts and ties under their graduation gown (no jeans).
- **Students:** should wear appropriate footwear and avoid sandals, flip flops and tennis/running shoes.
- **Graduation Cap:** decorating of your graduation cap is not permitted.

What to bring on the bus:

Students are responsible for bringing their cap and gown with them.

Personal belongings should not be brought on the bus.

Parent/Guest Seating:

Seating for family and friends is on a first come, first serve basis. There is no limit to the number of guests who may attend. The mobility impaired entrance is on the southwest end of the HEB Center. Mobility impaired guests may enter here or be dropped off and meet their parties after the vehicle has parked. If your parents or friends need a hearing-impaired signer, please have them sit in the lower rows of Section 115.

Parent/Guest Parking:

Parking is available immediately adjacent to the HEB Center. There is a \$5.00 fee per car to park. This fee is set by the HEB Center.

Meeting your Graduate:

All of the graduates will then exit through the back of the floor of the HEB Center to meet you at the flagpoles.

Graduates will be free to leave with family and/or friends.

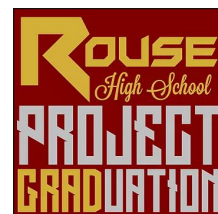

Volunteers' tasks are limitless - including such things as tutoring & mentoring students, chaperoning school dances & field trips, helping with our athletic & band booster clubs, helping with textbooks, serving at Teacher Appreciations and helping out in the guidance office.

For the safety of our students, Leander Independent School District requires **all potential volunteers** who plan to **work during the day or evenings** (before, during & after school) supporting any Club/Organization/Sports team, etc. to receive a background check by the Department of Public Safety (DPS). This check will be completed using the Raptor Volunteer Management System.

Here is how someone can become an 'APPROVED' LISD Volunteer:

1. Complete and submit the *NEW* Raptor Volunteer Application:

3. The background check should be complete in 2-3 business days.
4. Once approved, an email will be sent to the volunteer containing their login credentials and account information for their virtual volunteer profile.
5. When the volunteer is needed and it is during the school day, they MUST check-in at the front office and acquire a Volunteer Badge from the Receptionist.
